

According to the industry report, India has an existing fleet of approximately 548 aircrafts with another 925 aircrafts anticipated of being added in the next 5 years. India is the 3rd largest domestic aviation market and it is touted to be the largest domestic aviation market in the next decade and a half. And India is the fifth largest civil aviation market in the world behind the USA, China, Japan and the United Kingdom.

Under government's UDAN scheme, a massive expansion in the sector is expected to create 2.5 to 5 lakh employment opportunities to fill the gap in Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities. As the Indian Aviation sector is poised for rapid growth and increasing demand with need for professionals who combine technical skills with managerial acumen to take up leadership roles in this sector.
